Kelly Connor Spallinger: 35 Years of Singing for her Savior

TV-44's *Live Wire* producer Kelly Connor Spallinger is excited about beginning the show's new season on September 18th. She believes that the half-hour weekly program, which she and her husband Tim Spallinger co-host, provides an opportunity "to encourage other musicians to minister for Jesus name," said the Lafayette native.

Kelly understands the importance of using the talent that God has given you, since she is blessed with an amazing musical gift herself. She is well-known, not only in the Lima area, but nationally due to having recorded 19 albums and CDs. The seasoned singer was nominated for a Dove award in the mid-nineties.

The 44-year-old Allen East graduate began her career in music the same week that she gave her life to Christ at the tender age of nine. While attending a Vacation Bible School at the Lima Baptist Temple, Kelly and her cousin Melanie sang the hymn *He Touched Me* for the Friday Night VBS concert.

This first public performance was broadcast on WTN radio. People listening were amazed that "we could sing harmony at age nine, but that was from listening to the *Sweet Adelines*," explained Kelly. She often accompanied her mom Carol Connor to the female Barbershop group's practices.

Kelly's entire family is very musical, and by age 15, she became a member of the group *Fresh Surrender* with some other local musicians including Jim Boedicker. For 7 or 8 years, Kelly toured the tri-state area and made two albums at the Gaither Studios with *Fresh Surrender*. She later hosted TV-44's former *Music Line* show interviewing nationally known musicians.



However, life has not been without heartache for the acclaimed performer who experienced both a brain tumor and a "devastating divorce" in the mid-nineties. After a time of personal healing, Kelly found solace in singing for her Savior once again.

She is also the mother of two grown sons Kory, 23, and Dillon, 20, and two stepsons Eli, 16, and Ian, 9, since her marriage to Tim Spallinger in June 2004.

Kelly encourages musicians interested in appearing on *Live Wire* to send a non-professional demo and photo to her at the WTLW studios. She said, "People love *Live Wire*...to listen to the music...to see people they know."
